We have the pleasure of inviting you to take part in the international scientific conference on the art of gardening and historical dendrology. According to last year's findings, the proposed issue of this year's meeting, that will take place on 19-21 October, is:

Sustainable development goals in managing the cultural and historic landscape

The aim of the conference will be to undertake a discussion related to the idea of sustainable development in relation to cultural landscapes with its elements (parks, gardens, residences, organic farms, crops, etc.). In particular, emphasis will be placed on the theme developed in conservation, ecological, climatic, planning and landscape aspects.

It is a continuation of considerations related to the identification of current problems and challenges in the maintenance, preservation of the cultural heritage of towns, villages, open spaces and historic gardens. It is also important to highlight the sustainability of landscapes and their self-sustainability, biodiversity at different scales.

These reflections, respond to local, national as well as global efforts striving, according to the principle of longtermism, to preserve valuable landscapes for future generations.

Building on the new New European Bauhaus initiative and the fundamental law document in force in Poland, the provisions of the Polish Constitution, article 5 of the Basic Law stating that:

"The Republic of Poland shall safeguard the independence and inviolability of its territory, ensure the freedoms and rights of man and citizen and the security of its citizens, **protect the national heritage and ensure the protection of the environment, guided by the principle of sustainable development**" we will undertake an international discussion on the above mentioned topics.

We plan to present research aimed at inclusive activities, inspired by heritage, responding to needs and going beyond functionality, while acting in harmony with nature and the environment. This offers the chance to develop universal principles and guidelines, supported by a wealth of experience.

This year marks also the 30th anniversary of our conference and as special edition will address the theme of historical heritage for sustainable development. We plan to divide it into relevant discussion panels related to research on issues of conservation, protection, vegetation, heritage management and also cultural landscapes development.
